1 Gap Assessment Get Started; Find Holes

Who Qualifies?

Why Participate?

Partners may find a gap assessment to be a good place to start. Whether you have just begun to address your environmental impacts or are well on your way to developing an environmental management system (EMS), a gap assessment can help you move forward.

What Happens?

A gap assessment helps you compare your current environmental management practices, procedures and systems with P²AD Partnership Program requirements or with an EMS (based on the voluntary international standard ISO 14001:2004). By making this comparison, you can identify ways to develop or enhance your EMS.

2 Baseline Assessment Document Your Starting Point

Who Qualifies?

Yellow Level Partners

Why Participate?

If you need help documenting your resource use, waste streams and emissions, this assessment will be invaluable.

What Happens?

A baseline is a snapshot of your resource use, waste streams and emissions over a specified time period (usually the previous calendar year). This snapshot is a starting point against which you will measure your progress.

Before a baseline assessment can be scheduled, P²AD requires you to provide some preliminary information (e.g., utility bills). What type of information is required will depend on your particular assessment needs.

Why Participate?

If you are interested in assistance with one or more of the focus areas listed below, this assessment will help you direct your resources.

What Happens?
